COURSE OUTLINE

Visual language shapes our environment. We interact with communication design constantly in our everyday lives. This nationally recognised CUA50720 Diploma of Graphic Design provides students with an understanding of fundamental design practices including concept development, typography, layout design and creative thinking.

Students gain practical skills across the industry's leading creative software packages along with a sound knowledge of professional practice and design theory.

Students gain exposure to contemporary design trends and explore the dynamics of print and digital design including packaging, publication and website development. Participants develop a folio of creative work spanning branding and identity through to digital and print layout design, photography and drawing.

This program encourages students to develop their creative skill-set in preparation for a career in the field of design.

STUDY

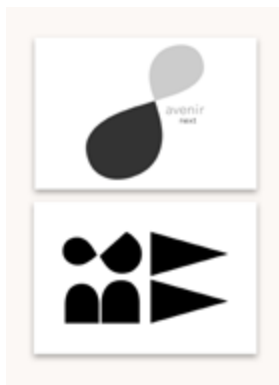
The CUA50720 Diploma of Graphic Design can be completed in one year. Full time study load is three days per week.

WHO CAN APPLY

The course is open to year 12, non-year 12, mature aged applicants, and international students. The course suits beginners to the more advanced. An ATAR is not required and Vet Student Loans are available.

CAREER OPTIONS

Career opportunities include advertising agencies, design studios, publishing houses, pre-press and quick press firms. You will also be equipped to set up your own design business or work in a freelance capacity. Students can go onto further university level study and receive credit from the Diploma.

NEW YORK / VENICE BIENNALE / BERLIN

Latrobe College students and non-students also have the opportunity to attend art tours to either New York, the Venice Biennale or Berlin. For two weeks students become fully immersed in art and undertake drawing and studio workshops, producing an art journal. On return to Melbourne, participants are invited to participate in an exhibition of the journals at the Latrobe College Gallery.
