DIPLOMA OF PHOTOGRAPHY & DIGITAL IMAGING

COURSE OUTLINE

In this one year intensive program students learn a wide range of photo-practice skills and techniques, from fine art and photo documentation through to advertising and commercial photography. Photo-techniques from analogue to the latest digital imaging are covered.

Small class sizes and one-to-one teaching allow students to rapidly forge their creative direction. The program is dedicated to image-makers and artists interested in developing their work, building their technical skills, and engaging in classes that help them to understand their work in relation to the images that shape our contemporary culture.

Students gain exhibition experience within the Latrobe College Gallery. The course enables students to go onto degree level study or to enter the industry as a photographer.



STUDY

The CUA50920 Diploma of Photography & Digital Imaging can be completed in one year of full-time study. Full time study load is three to four days per week. Part-time study is available.

Students interested in a mix of visual art and photography may choose the Diploma of Visual Art - Photography electives.

WHO CAN APPLY

The course is open to year 12, non-year 12, mature aged applicants, and international students. The course suits beginners to the more advanced. An ATAR is not required and Vet Student Loans are available.

Each year Latrobe College students and non-students have the opportunity to attend art tours to either New York, the Venice Biennale or Berlin. For two weeks students become fully immersed in art and undertake drawing and studio workshops, producing an art journal. On return to Melbourne, participants are invited to participate in an exhibition of the journals at the Latrobe College Gallery.

Commercial photographers can find opportunities as a photojournalist, art photographer, fashion photographer, sports photographer, property photographer commercial / advertising photographer, medical / scientific photographer or social photographer.

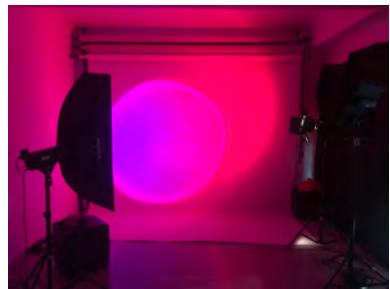
ENTRY OPTIONS
