# DIPLOMA / ADVANCED DIPLOMA OF VISUAL ARTS

## COURSE OUTLINE

In our nationally accredited CUA51120 and CUA60720 Diploma and Advanced Diploma of Visual Arts, students acquire a range of technical and conceptual skills for art making whilst developing an individual and personal direction.

Students can choose to stream in either Art or Photography. Study options include studio art, painting methods, photography, sculpture, drawing, contemporary art theory and digital & moving image.

Small class sizes and one-to-one teaching as well as an individual studio, allow students to rapidly forge creative direction and identify an independent art practice. Students have the opportunity to participate in study trips to New York, the Venice Biennale or Berlin, with credit towards their course.

## CAREER OPTIONS

Career opportunities include visual artist, photographer, animator, illustrator, designer, gallery assistant, gallery director, visual art teacher, museum conservator, exhibition curator and visual art industry expert.



## STUDY

Students have the option of studying for one or two years. The Diploma is first year and the Advanced Diploma is second year. Full time study is three days per week.

Part time study and single subject enrolment is also available.

## ENTRY OPTIONS

There are three intake options per year. Students can elect to begin at the start of any term.

## NEW YORK / VENICE BIENNALE / BERLIN

Latrobe College students and non-students also have the opportunity to attend art tours to either New York, the Venice Biennale or Berlin. For two weeks students become fully immersed in art and undertake drawing and studio workshops, producing an art journal. On return to Melbourne, participants are invited to participate in an exhibition of the journals at the Latrobe College Gallery.

The course is open to year 12, non-year 12, mature aged applicants, and international students. The course suits beginners to the more advanced. An ATAR is not required and Vet Student Loans are available.
